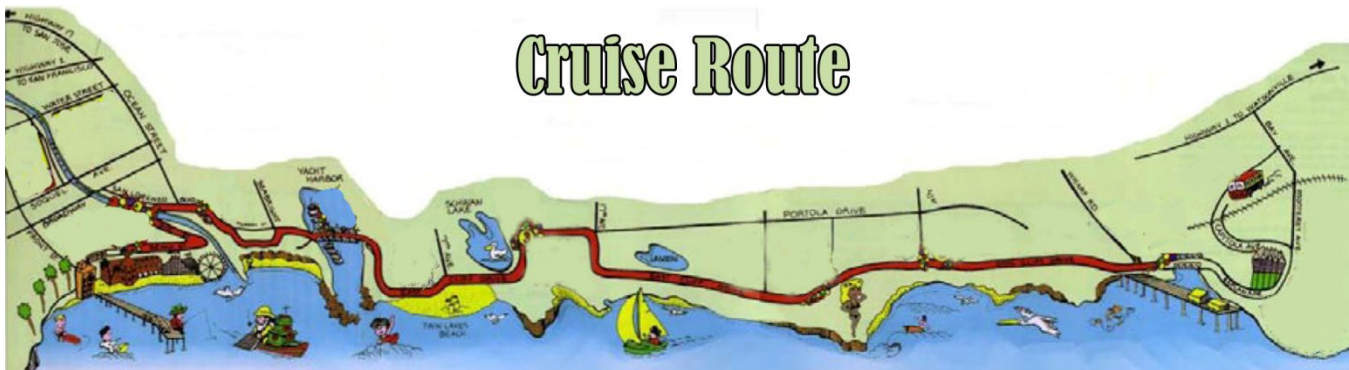

- All vehicles participating in the cruise will stage outside the Seaside Parking Lot of the Santa Cruz Beach Boardwalk. Form two (2) lines in the street starting at 7:00 am. Participants planning to park together should line up side by side (some folks arrive as early as 5:30 to line up). Restrooms are available.
- The cruise starts between 8:30 am and 9:00 am and ends approximately 30 min. later in the Capitola Village.
- Vintage police cars and fire trucks will lead the cruise with a marked police motorcycle escort.
- All rules of the road will be followed unless directed otherwise by a uniformed officer.
- Upon arrival in the Capitola Village, only participant vehicles enter by way of Capitola Avenue where the Parking Crew will guide you. Your vehicle will be parked for the remainder of the day. Sorry, no Ins or Outs during the event.



(The cruise will follow the same route used for the Wharf-to-Wharf running race)

- 1) Follow Beach St., Beach St. will turn into 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
- 2) Make Right on Riverside over the bridge
- 3) Make Right on San Lorenzo, San Lorenzo turns into East Cliff
- 4) Follow E. Cliff up the hill staying left, E. Cliff turns into Murray Street
- 5) Continue on Murray Street, Murray Street turns into Eaton. Follow Eaton towards harbor
- 6) Right on Lake Avenue towards the Harbor/Crow's Nest, follow Lake Avenue to East Cliff
- 7) Make right on E. Cliff and continue on E. Cliff to the intersection of 17<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- 8) Stay right on East Cliff and continue to follow East Cliff along the coast to Opal Cliff
- 9) Make right on Opal Cliff, Opal Cliff ends at the intersection of Portola and Cliff Drive
- 10) Make right on Cliff Dr., down the hill and across the Stockton Avenue Bridge
- 11) Make right onto Capitola Avenue to be directed by the Parking Crew to your parking location
